Do Not Be Deceived

You will find that most of this is much of the same from the previous parts, but He has put it on my heart to bring it up again so that you might see it in a different way, or just as a reminder, because we are in the last days, and He does not want to lose anyone out of ignorance or forgetfulness.

MT 24:1 "Jesus left the temple and was walking away when His disciples came up to Him to call His attention to its buildings. [2] "Do you see all these things?" He asked. "I tell you the truth, not one stone here will be left on another; every one will be thrown down."

MT 24:3 "As Jesus was sitting on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately. "Tell us," they said, "when will this happen, and what will be the sign of your coming and of the end of the age?"

MT 24:4 "Jesus answered: "Watch out that no one deceives you. [5] For many will come in My name, claiming, `I am the Christ, ' and will deceive many. [6] You will hear of wars and rumors of wars, but see to it that you are not alarmed. Such things must happen, but the end is still to come. [7] Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be famines and earthquakes in various places. [8] All these are the beginning of birth pains."

Note: Here He says to not be alarmed. What does alarmed mean, it means to not be afraid, or worry, or fret, or become full of stress and anxiety. In short it means, to trust Him and to keep your peace.

MT 24:9 "Then you will be handed over to be persecuted and put to death, and you will be hated by all nations because of Me. [10] At that time many will turn away from the faith and will betray and hate each other, [11] and many false prophets will appear and **deceive** many people. [12] Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold, [13] <u>but he who stands firm to the end will be saved</u>. [14] And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.

MT 24:15 "So when you see standing in the holy place `the abomination that causes desolation,' spoken of through the prophet Daniel--let the reader understand-- [16] then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains. [17] Let no one on the roof of his house go down to take anything out of the house. [18] Let no one in the field go back to get his cloak. [19] How dreadful it will be in those days for pregnant women and nursing mothers! [20] Pray that your flight will not take place in winter or on the Sabbath. [21]

For then there will be great distress, unequaled from the beginning of the world until now--and never to be equaled again. [22] *If those days had not been cut short, no one would survive, but for the sake of the elect those days will be shortened.* [23] At that time if anyone says to you, `Look, here is the Christ!' or, `There He is!' do not believe it. [24] For false Christs and false prophets will appear and perform great signs and miracles to **deceive** even the elect--if that were possible. [25] See, I have told you ahead of time.

MT 24:26 "So if anyone tells you, `There He is, out in the desert,' do not go out; or, `Here He is, in the inner rooms,' do not believe it. [27] For as lightning that comes from the east is visible even in the west, so will be the coming of the Son of Man. [28] Wherever there is a carcass, there the vultures will gather."

MT 24:29 "Immediately after the distress of those days

" `the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from the sky, and the heavenly bodies will be shaken.'

MT 24:30 "At that time the sign of the Son of Man will appear in the sky, and all the nations of the earth will mourn. They will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of the sky, with power and great glory. [31] And He will send His angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather His elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other.

MT 24:32 "Now learn this lesson from the fig tree: As soon as its twigs get tender and its leaves come out, you know that summer is near. [33] Even so, when you see all these things, you know that it is near, right at the door. [34] I tell you the truth, this generation will certainly not pass away until all these things have happened. [35] Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will never pass away.

MT 24:36 "No one knows about that day or hour, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father. [37] As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man. [38] For in the days before the flood, people were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, up to the day Noah entered the ark; [39] and they knew nothing about what would happen until the flood came and took them all away. That is how it will be at the coming of the Son of Man. [40] Two men will be in the field; one will be taken and the other left. [41] Two women will be grinding with a hand mill; one will be taken and the other left."

MT 24:42 "Therefore keep watch, because you do not know on what day your Lord will come. [43] But understand this: If the owner of the house had known at what time of night the thief was coming, he would have kept watch and would not have let his house be broken into. [44] So you also must be ready, because the Son of Man will come at an hour when you do not expect Him.

MT 24:45 "Who then is the faithful and wise servant, whom the master has put in charge of the servants in his household to give them their food at the proper time? [46] It will be good for that servant whose master finds him doing so when he returns. [47] I tell you the truth, he will put him in charge of all his possessions. [48] *But suppose that servant is wicked and says to himself, 'My master is staying away a long time,' [49] and he then begins to beat his fellow servants and to eat and drink with drunkards. [50] The master of that servant will come on a day when he does not expect him and at an hour he is not aware of. [51] He will cut him to pieces and assign him a place with the hypocrites, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.''*

One of the main subjects Jesus was constantly telling His disciples was to not be deceived. The devil is a liar and the father of lies, and he is the great deceiver.

That is all the devil really has: deception. He whispers deceptive things in your ears and minds, little thoughts of evil things to entice and draw you away from the Lord and the gospel of the truth. They all sound good, they look good and they might even taste good, but it is really nothing it is like pork rinds; they also look good, smell good and even taste good, but they are full of nothing, no nutrients, protein, no substance to sustain your life. You can starve eating just pork rinds.

For the longest time not many people believed that God talked to us, that God does not influences us, that God does not lead, guide and direct us; but now that many prophets have been successfully preaching that God does communicate to us and more, and people are believing. Then guess what, the great forger, deceiver and liar is taking that idea of God communicating with us and is counterfeiting it. He is pretending to be God to us, and trying to influence us by counterfeiting the way God has and is communicating to us.

He is pretending to be God's small still voice, God's dreams, God's visions, and the like. But they are not God's they are the devil doing it, leading you astray by this deception.

Above when Jesus says,

. [23] "At that time if anyone says to you, `Look, here is the Christ!' or, `There He is!' do not believe it. [24] For false Christs and false prophets will appear and perform great signs and miracles to **deceive** even the elect--if that were possible. [25] See, I have told you ahead of time.

MT 24:26 "So if anyone tells you, `There He is, out in the desert,' do not go out; or, `Here He is, in the inner rooms,' do not believe it. [27] For as lightning that comes from the east is visible even in the west, so will be the coming of the Son of Man. [28] Wherever there is a carcass, there the vultures will gather."

He not only means other false religions, false cults, false teachings, but He is also saying to beware of the small still counterfeit voice that is lying to you. Do not follow this false small still voice either. That is why He says, to test every spirit. That means the spirits that are falsely communicating to you too.

1JN 4:1 "Dear friends, **do not believe every spirit**, **but test the spirits to see whether they are from God**, because many false prophets have gone out into the world. [2] This is how you can recognize the Spirit of God: Every spirit that acknowledges that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God, [3] but every spirit that does not acknowledge Jesus is not from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist, which you have heard is coming and even now is already in the world."

2TH 2:1 "Concerning the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our being gathered to Him, we ask you, brothers, [2] not to become easily unsettled or alarmed by some prophecy, report or letter supposed to have come from us, saying that the day of the Lord has already come. [3] **Don't let anyone deceive you in any way, for that day will not come until the rebellion occurs and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the man doomed to destruction.** [4] He will oppose and will exalt himself over everything that is called God or is worshiped, so that he sets himself up in God's temple, proclaiming himself to be God."

EPH 5:3 "But among you there must not be even a hint of sexual immorality, or of any kind of impurity, or of greed, because these are improper for God's holy people. [4] Nor should there be **obscenity, foolish talk or coarse joking**, which are out of place, but rather thanksgiving. [5] For of this you can be sure: No immoral, impure or greedy person--such a man is an idolater--has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God. [6] Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of such things God's wrath comes on those who are disobedient. [7] <u>Therefore do not be partners with them."</u>

COL 2:1 "I want you to know how much I am struggling for you and for those at Laodicea, and for all who have not met me personally. [2] My purpose is that they may be encouraged in heart and united in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, *Christ, [3] in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.* [4] **I tell you this so that no one may deceive you by fine-sounding arguments.** [5] For though I am absent from you in body, I am present with you in spirit and delight to see how orderly you are and how firm your faith in Christ is."

What is the point of being deceived?

What happens when you are deceived? Your mind is turned in that direction of the deception, your mind is being twisted against the truth, your mind becomes full of doubt, your mind is being drawn into another direction or path, but nothing happens until your mind DECIDES to follow that deception, then the deception has worked. Above He says to not become partners with evil; well when do you become partners with evil? It is when you decide to agree with the evil, when you decide that the evil thought is right and that you are missing out or of that like; it is when you decide with the evil, now you are their partners in crime and all evil things.

If he can deceive you to believe in something else—other then God—then he has changed your mind, and that change will take away your belief or trust in God, and our Lord Jesus. When he can do that he has stolen your faith in God and Jesus. And without your faith, you become unrighteous, you become an unforgiven sinner again, you have lost your crown of life, "for because of such things God's wrath comes on those who are disobedient." Remember Ephesians 2:

EPH 2:1 "As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins, [2] in which you used to live when you followed the ways of this world and of the ruler of the kingdom of the air, the spirit who is now at work in those who are disobedient. [3] All of us also lived among them at one time, gratifying the cravings of our sinful nature and following its desires and thoughts. Like the rest, we were by nature objects of wrath. [4] But because of His great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, [5] made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions--it is by grace you have been saved. [6] And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with Him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus, [7] in order that in the coming ages He might show the incomparable riches of His grace, expressed in His kindness to us in Christ Jesus. [8] For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith--and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God-- [9] not by works, so that no one can boast. [10] For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do."

EPH 2:11 "Therefore, remember that formerly you who are Gentiles by birth and called "uncircumcised" by those who call themselves "the circumcision" (that done in the body by the hands of men)-- [12] remember that at that time you were separate from Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel and foreigners to the covenants of the promise, **without hope and without God in the world.** [13] But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near through the blood of Christ."

You are saved and stay saved by keeping your faith, which is to keep your decision to believe in Jesus and the sacrifice He made by dying on the cross and the spilling of His blood. Your decision to trust God that He loves you greatly and will only do what is best for you, and that you act on your belief and trust in God; thereby, putting your faith into righteous actions. For only the righteous will enter heaven. Only obedient Children of God will enter heaven, only those who keep their faith in Christ will be saved.

So what does all of this mean, it means that the war between good and evil is the battle for your minds and hearts, for your faith, and for you decision to follow God and trust His work, or it is to follow the world and its lies—the path to HELL.

This is why He says:

MT 7:15 "Watch out for false prophets. They come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ferocious wolves. [16] **By their fruit you will recognize them**. Do people pick grapes from thorn bushes, or figs from thistles? [17] Likewise every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. [18] A good tree cannot bear bad

fruit, and a bad tree cannot bear good fruit. [19] Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. [20] Thus, by their fruit you will recognize them.

MT 7:21 "Not everyone who says to Me, `Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven. [22] Many will say to Me on that day, `Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name drive out demons and perform many miracles?' [23] Then I will tell them plainly, `I never knew you. Away from Me, you evildoers!'

MT 7:24 "Therefore everyone who hears these words of Mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. [25] The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock. [26] But everyone who hears these words of Mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. [27] The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash."

Is He talking about one time or all of our lives? How could it be anything but of all of our lives? His words live forever; well at least for our lifetime. So He is talking about our life time that if we do not keep His words all of our life, then we will fail and we will follow our new father--the devil—to hell.

It is never, once saved always saved. If it were, He would not make such a big deal about being deceived. He says that even the elect will be deceived that means those who have been saved. Above it says:

[22] "Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name drive out demons and perform many miracles?"

How can a person prophesy, if they did not know the Lord and have faith in Him? How can you drive out demons and perform miracles, if you did not have the power and authority of the Lord? You cannot, only the power of God can do that through a righteous person.

That means that at one time they were righteous, saved and filled with the power and authority of the Holy Spirit, and that can only happened if they were crowned with the crown of life.

So He is now saying that because you have been deceived, you do not hold the truth of the Kingdom of God in you, you have allowed evil spirits to come and live in you again, because you have believed the deception instead of God's truth. You are now being disobedient, and all those who are disobedient are subject to God's wrath; hence, He says,

[23] "Then I will tell them plainly, 'I never knew you. Away from Me, you evildoers!"

Remember, evil does not mean the devil, it means to be disobedient--Ephesians 2.

How to Not <u>be</u> Deceived

The devil uses things of yourself against you. Your wants, desires, pleasures, needs and dislikes. A simple summary is, he uses your selfishness against you. If your wants, desires, pleasures and needs are based on unselfish attitude, then there is no sin in that as long as you are doing it out of obedience to the Lord. He also uses your dislikes, which also comes out of your selfishness, for the Lord says to love everyone, and you cannot do that if you dislike them.

So in short, if you do not have any selfish desires, wants, or needs, and if you can accept follow all of the Lord's commands and all things of the Kingdom of God, so that you do not have any dislikes or things of the flesh as in Galatians 5, then you will not be deceived.

Also remember this:

MT 16:21 "From that time on Jesus began to explain to His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things at the hands of the elders, chief priests and teachers of the law, and that He must be killed and on the third day be raised to life."

MT 16:22 "Peter took Him aside and began to rebuke Him. "Never, Lord!" he said. "This shall never happen to You!""

MT 16:23 "Jesus turned and said to Peter, "Get behind Me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to Me; you do not have in mind the things of God, but the things of men.""

MT 16:24 "Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone would come after Me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow Me. [25] For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for Me will find it. [26] What good will it be for a man if he gains the whole world, yet forfeits his soul? Or what can a man give in exchange for his soul? [27] For the Son of Man is going to come in His Father's glory with His angels, and then He will reward each person according to what he has done. [28] I tell you the truth, some who are standing here will not taste death before they see the Son of Man coming in his kingdom.""

Peter was very selfish here, He did not want to be separated from the Lord, he wanted to stay with the Lord always, and follow Him as He created a new Kingdom. They believed that when the Savior comes, He will create a new heaven and new earth, but he was not listening to Jesus, for that was not so until later in His second coming.

Also the book of Galatians goes over this very good. If you live in and by the Spirit you will not live in the flesh—be subject to evil spirits. Do you remember Window control in Volume 3 chapter 4?

The word "BE" above, what does that mean? Well in God's terms, it means to have an attitude. It means to **not** have an attitude of allowing yourself to be subject to deception. Or the opposite is to have the attitude of trusting God and that He will lead you in to all truth, to have the attitude of

believing God and all of His words and believing that He will always keep His promises; it means to have the attitude of Christ who died on the Cross for us, who was the most unselfish person in the world. God promises to lead His children into all truth and that His truth will set you free. This can only happen through the attitude of selflessness-being unselfish like Christ.

Note: As reminder again, the way to be anything or to have an attitude is to make a serous decision to be that way. It only happens by your sincere decisions—again the battle for your mind and heart.

JN 14:6 "Jesus answered, **"I am the way and the truth and the life.** No one comes to the Father except through Me. [7] If you really knew Me, you would know My Father as well. From now on, you do know Him and have seen Him."

JN 14:8 Philip said, "Lord, show us the Father and that will be enough for us."

JN 14:9 "Jesus answered: "Don't you know Me, Philip, even after I have been among you such a long time? Anyone who has seen Me has seen the Father. How can you say, 'Show us the Father'? [10] Don't you believe that I am in the Father, and that the Father is in Me? The words I say to you are not just My own. Rather, it is the Father, living in Me, who is doing His work. [11] Believe Me when I say that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me; or at least believe on the evidence of the miracles themselves. [12] **I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in Me will do what I have been doing**. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father. [13] And I will do whatever you ask in My name, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father. [14] You may ask Me for anything in My name, and I will do it."

JN 14:15 **"If you love Me, you will obey what I command**. [16] And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Counselor to be with you forever-- [17] **the Spirit of truth.** The world cannot accept Him, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him. But you know Him, for He lives with you and will be in you. [18] I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you. [19] Before long, the world will not see Me anymore, but you will see Me. Because I live, you also will live. [20] On that day you will realize that I am in My Father, and you are in Me, and I am in you. [21] Whoever has My commands and obeys them, he is the one who loves Me. He who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I too will love him and show Myself to him."

What does all of this mean, lets review, because it has been said many times before, but it is worth reminding you and so repeating. For Peter says:

2PE 1:12 "So I will always remind you of these things, even though you know them and are firmly established in the truth you now have. [13] I think it is right to refresh your memory as long as I live in the tent of this body, [14] because I know that I will soon put it aside, as our Lord Jesus Christ has made clear to me. [15] And I will make every effort to see that after my departure you will always be able to remember these things."

2PE 1:16 "We did not follow cleverly invented stories when we told you about the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of His Majesty. [17] For He received honor and glory from God the Father when the voice came to Him from the Majestic Glory, saying, "This is My Son, whom I love; with Him I am well pleased." [18] We ourselves heard this voice that came from heaven when we were with Him on the sacred mountain."

2PE 1:19 "And we have the word of the prophets made more certain, and you will do well to pay attention to it, as to a light shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts. [20] <u>Above all, you must understand that no prophecy of Scripture came about by the prophet's own interpretation. [21] For prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit."</u>

2PE 2:1 "But there were also false prophets among the people, just as there will be false teachers among you. *They will secretly introduce destructive heresies, even denying the sovereign Lord who bought them--bringing swift destruction on themselves.* [2] Many will follow their shameful ways and will bring the way of truth into disrepute. [3] In their greed these teachers will exploit you with stories they have made up. Their condemnation has long been hanging over them, and their destruction has not been sleeping."

I am not Peter, but I will speak as the Holy Spirit leads.

So if you do not allow the deceiver to change your mind, to lead you astray as to give you doubts of your faith, or to change your belief, then you will not be deceived. It is a decision to have the attitude of Christ and the mind of Christ, and with that the Holy Spirit will always lead you into the truth and will always keep you free, to keep your decision to keep your faith, and so stay righteous and holy, thereby keeping your crown of life.

James is another book to learn how to not be deceived.

JAS 1:2 "Consider it pure joy, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds, [3] because you know that the testing of your faith develops perseverance. [4] Perseverance must finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything. [5] If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him. [6] But when he asks, he must believe and not doubt, because he who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. [7] That man should not think he will receive anything from the Lord; [8] he is a double-minded man, unstable in all he does."

JAS 1:9 "The brother in humble circumstances ought to take pride in his high position. [10] But the one who is rich should take pride in his low position, because he will pass away like a wild flower. [11] For the sun rises with scorching heat and withers

the plant; its blossom falls and its beauty is destroyed. In the same way, the rich man will fade away even while he goes about his business."

Note: Being humble is easily put as having the attitude of unselfishness—the action of being unselfish—always wanting to please the Lord.

JAS 1:12 "Blessed is the man who perseveres under trial, because when he has stood the test, he will receive the <u>crown of life</u> that God has promised to those who love Him."

JAS 1:13 "When tempted, no one should say, "God is tempting me." For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He tempt anyone; [14] **but each one is tempted when**, **by his own evil desire**, he is dragged away and enticed. [15] Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death."

JAS 1:16 "**Don't be deceived, my dear brothers**. [17] Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the *Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows*. [18] He chose to give us birth through the word of truth, that we might be a kind of first fruits of all He created."

JAS 1:19 "My dear brothers, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry, [20] for man's anger does not bring about the righteous life that God desires. [21] Therefore, **get rid of all moral filth and the evil that is so prevalent** and humbly accept the word planted in you, which can save you."

JAS 1:22 "Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says. [23] Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like a man who looks at his face in a mirror [24] and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like. [25] But the man who looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues to do this, not forgetting what he has heard, but doing it--he will be blessed in what he does."

Finally, the whole purpose of the website is to teach you the truth of God and the Kingdom of God and in doing so, is to teach you how to not be deceived, but to be and have the attitude of Christ, the mind of Christ and how to live in the Spirit. If you are having problems doing this please re-read the website again.

Please remember two things, 1. "Window Control" and 2. Everything depends on your decisions. Not your feelings, but your decisions.

GAL 5:22 "But the fruit of the Spirit is **love**, **joy**, **peace**, **patience**, **kindness**, **goodness**, **faithfulness**, **[23] gentleness and self-control**. Against such things there is no law. [24] Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the sinful nature with its passions and desires. [25] Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit. [26] Let us not become conceited, provoking and envying each other.

God's feelings are love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. These feelings come by your faith in Jesus as a reward for your decisions to be righteous. God's feelings will not come except by your decision. Unlike the evil feelings that barge in on you, press you, obsess you, demand you, push and prod you, entice you and force you.

GAL 5:19 "The acts of the sinful nature are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; [20] idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions [21] and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. <u>I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this</u> will not inherit the kingdom of God."

Do not forget, ego or pride or haughtiness, lust for money and anything else, such as anger, and evil desires.

God's feelings are controlled by your decisions and are given to you as a reward for your obedience. Where the world's feelings are sent to control you. They do not respect your free will like God does.

Note: You were meant to control feelings and to not let feelings control you.

All of these evil things, and their deceptive counter parts, must be removed and the window must be kept shut to prevent them from coming back into you, or you will end up like this:

MT 12:43 "When an evil spirit comes out of a man, it goes through arid places seeking rest and does not find it. [44] Then it says, 'I will return to the house I left.' **When it arrives, it finds the house unoccupied, swept clean and put in order.** [45] Then it goes and takes with it seven other spirits more wicked than itself, and they go in and live there. And the final condition of that man is worse than the first. That is how it will be with this wicked generation."

You must keep your house, which is you, full of the only One that is powerful enough with the authority of God to keep all evil spirits out: The Holy Spirit. As long as you are obedient and righteous, He will live in you and with you, and when the evil spirits come, you can ask Him to keep them out, but in order to ask you must have faith and again that comes from your decision to believe in Him, to trust Him and then to put your faith into action by asking Him to protect you, to fill you and to lead you into all truth.

If you are tempted by evil and you decide to not follow it or agree with it, you have just banished the evil one, and he will not enter you, because of your faith and the Holy Spirit only works on your faith. But if you decide that you agree with what is being presented to you by the evil one, then you have just opened his window, and let him in you. Because you have been deceived, you have now just become disobedient and unrighteous, and you have now become unfaithful, so the Holy Spirit has to leave you and He will take your crown of life with Him, leaving your house empty—allowing the evil

spirit to enter you with his friends. You are now full of evil and you must do some thing about it or you will lose you salvation.

Please note, that He has left living in you, but He has not left you. Remember He said that I am with you and I will live in you. When He lives in you, He is also anointing you. So when He leaves you, you only stops living in you and He stops anointing you, but He has not abandoned you, for He is still with you, just not living in you and not anointing you. This is important because He always promises:

HEB 13:4 "Marriage should be honored by all, and the marriage bed kept pure, for God will judge the adulterer and all the sexually immoral. [5] Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said,

"Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you.""

HEB 13:6 "So we say with confidence,

"The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?""

But remember, God is quick to forgive. So at some point you remember the gospel, and your make your decision to have faith in God, and you act on it by asking for forgiveness, and then you repent from your disobedience, then with your forgiveness, God will send the Holy Spirit back to live in you and anoint you. Then once the Holy Spirit is back, He will close that evil window and clean out your house of all-evil; He will once again live in you. At that point He will give back to you, your crown of life.
