20.4 Small Still Voice of God

What is all of this leading to? The answer is easy, to live with God, to live for God and to live obeying God (being righteous).

Lets look at another man who thought he was doing this: Elijah—a man like us.

JAS 5:17 “Elijah was a man just like us. He prayed earnestly that it would not rain, and it did not rain on the land for three and a half years. [18] Again he prayed, and the heavens gave rain, and the earth produced its crops.”

1KI 19:7 “The angel of the LORD came back a second time and touched him and said, "Get up and eat, for the journey is too much for you." [8] So he got up and ate and drank. Strengthened by that food, he traveled forty days and forty nights until he reached Horeb, the mountain of God. [9] There he went into a cave and spent the night.”

And the word of the LORD came to him: "What are you doing here, Elijah?"

1KI 19:10 “He replied, "I have been very zealous for the LORD God Almighty. The Israelites have rejected your covenant, broken down your altars, and put your prophets to death with the sword. I am the only one left, and now they are trying to kill me too.””

1KI 19:11 “The LORD said, "Go out and stand on the mountain in the presence of the LORD, for the LORD is about to pass by.”

Then a great and powerful wind tore the mountains apart and shattered the rocks before the LORD, but the LORD was not in the wind. After the wind there was an earthquake, but the LORD was not in the earthquake. [12] After the earthquake came a fire, but the LORD was not in the fire. **And after the fire came a gentle whisper.** (“A small still voice”—Berkeley version) [13] When Elijah heard it, he pulled his cloak over his face and went out and stood at the mouth of the cave.

Then a voice said to him, "What are you doing here, Elijah?"”

1KI 19:14 “He replied, "I have been very zealous for the LORD God Almighty. The Israelites have rejected your covenant, broken down

your altars, and put your prophets to death with the sword. I am the only one left, and now they are trying to kill me too.””

1KI 19:15 “The LORD said to him, "Go back the way you came, and go to the Desert of Damascus. When you get there, anoint Hazael king over Aram. [16] Also, anoint Jehu son of Nimshi king over Israel, and anoint Elisha son of Shaphat from Abel Meholah to succeed you as prophet. [17] Jehu will put to death any who escape the sword of Hazael, and Elisha will put to death any who escape the sword of Jehu. [18] Yet I reserve seven thousand in Israel--all whose knees have not bowed down to Baal and all whose mouths have not kissed him.””

So why is this important? Because it is the preferred way of God talking to us. If you notice here that it was the “Word of the Lord” said, then later it says “a voice said”. They are different. If the Lord only talks to us through the Word, then why did He go through so much trouble to show Himself to Elijah as a Small still voice? And when did Elijah hear this voice? Well he heard the voice only after he was obedient and stood at the entrance of the cave. The voice did not penetrate the cave, only the Word did.

This is very important to understand. As long as Elijah was living in his feelings, here it was the feeling of failure, depression, guilt, and shame, God could not talk to him with His voice into Elijah’s heart. But the Word can. The Word is a 2-edged sword that can penetrate anything, even the deepest despair, pit or cave we are hiding in. But not His voice. Only when we are righteous can we hear the voice. Once Elijah got rid of these feelings (resist the devil and he will flee), then with his windows closed and the door to God open, did he receive the voice of God. Please read the rest of 1King 19 and on, to see what fantastic things Elijah did after he started listening to the voice of God. See what courage and wisdom, and miracles that God was able to do through him once he started to listening and obeying the Small Still Voice of God.

This is how God is going to do in today too. This is being one with God as in John 14, 15, and 16. This is how He is going to fulfill the great commission.

MT 17:10 “The disciples asked him, "Why then do the teachers of the law say that Elijah must come first?"

MT 17:11 Jesus replied, "To be sure, **Elijah comes and will restore all things.** [12] But I tell you, Elijah has already come, and they did not recognize him, but have done to him everything they wished. In the same way the Son of Man is going to suffer at their hands." [13] Then the disciples understood that he was talking to them about John the Baptist.

MAL 4:5 "See, **I will send you the prophet Elijah before that great and dreadful day of the LORD comes.** [6] He will turn the hearts

of the fathers to their children, and the hearts of the children to their fathers; or else I will come and strike the land with a curse."

Before Jesus returns, He will send Elijah to restore all things. This is how. Elijah was the first to live by the Small Still Voice, to be the first, besides Adam and Eve, to live as one with God; everyone who can do this too. For unlike Elijah's time, all men can have the Holy Spirit to live in them, and through Him, we can all obey the Small Still voice of God. Everyone who follows what has been written in these books, will be able to hear the Small Still Voice. This comes with the Holy Spirit and when you have closed all of your windows and removed all evil from your heart, then the static noise that prevents you from hearing God will be gone, allowing you to hear God as He speaks to you, because you are now one with God because there is no evil separating you from God.

This is the whole purpose of these books, to teach everyone how to live for God so that they can live with God and listen to the Small Still Voice; so that God can use them to restore all things, before He returns. For if all things necessary are not restored, then Jesus cannot return.

Why are you still here? Why are you still on earth? If God loved you so much, why have you not gone to heaven? Why has God not taken you home to be with Him? If He really loved you, why would He allow you to still suffer being on this earth, living with evil, having to fight evil, suffering and being tortured by evil, where if you were home with Him, there would be no more tears, eternal love, eternal peace, eternal joy and happiness with God.

Why does it say, "If you remain in Me and I remain in you, then you can ask what you want and it will be done for you." Why doesn't God say, "If you remain in Me and I remain in You, you can come home and be with Me"?

I mean if you are saved, then why doesn't God just take us home right then and there? Well the answer comes back to the beginning of this manual, because God's first rule is that He cannot do anything unless someone prays and obeys Him, because He wants us to help Him to save everyone else. It is by the unity of faith that will rock the world.

The reason we are still here is because these are the end days, this is the time of the great commission, and this is the time of the great harvest. God is delaying His return, so that we have time to bring in the great harvest so that not a single person that has been given to Jesus would be lost. That is the destiny of all Christians in these end days.

God knows that if you remain in Him and He in you, then all you will be doing is the destiny He has laid out for you and if you pray your destiny, then that is He will and if you pray His will, He will do it. So in that way, when He remains in you and you

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remain in Him then you can ask for what you want and it will be done, because what you want will be the destiny He has set before you and (again) when you pray what you want you are praying your destiny—His will for you.

So God has told a prophet--Graham Cooke--that this is a new era, this is the time of the great army of God. It is no longer the time of the great individuals where one of two great evangelists go out and to all of the work or one or two pastors have great churches and they do everything. But rather this is the time for many hidden Children of God obeying God and each doing their job for God: going and doing as God leads them.

And as another prophet--Daniel from Taiwan--was told, that this is the time for the UNITY of FAITH of all of God's children, where everyone does the work; lots and lots of people praying, evangelizing, healing, teaching, pasturing and apostlizing.

There is an old saying, give a person a fish and they eat for a day; but teach a person to fish and they eat for a lifetime. THAT is the purpose of this manual, to teach everyone to fish.

God wants everyone to follow the great commission, and what is that? Well read the bible:

MT 28:16 "Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. [17] When they saw Him, they worshiped Him; but some doubted. [18] Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. [19] **Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, [20] and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.** And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

How many people are there on this earth today? Millions, and millions and millions of people. So what is it going to take millions of people to fulfill this great commission. Are you one of them? What can you do?

Well you can do whatever God has asked you to do—listen to His small still voice, for He will give you whatever you need to do it. Your job is to just obey Him.

When the our brain agrees with the understanding of our heart that is in agreement with God, then revelation and anointing of God and His Spirit will move in and on you.

MT 10:6 "Go rather to the lost sheep of
